Privacy Policy for T-overtone.art Website

User privacy protection is of utmost importance to the Citizens of Common Europe Foundation. Therefore, users of the T-overtone.art website are guaranteed high standards of privacy protection. The Citizens of Common Europe Foundation, as the data controller, ensures the security of the data provided by the users.

The Administrator's aim is to provide proper information to users about their rights and obligations related to the processing of personal data, particularly in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR").

A user is any individual whose data is processed and who uses the T-overtone.art website or the electronic services available through the website.

The Administrator of personal data provided by users on the T-overtone.art website is the Citizens of Common Europe Foundation, located at Andromeda 20, Apt. 5, 44-117 Gliwice, Poland, National Court Register (KRS) number 0000548396, National Official Register of Economic Units (REGON) number 36101097000000, Tax Identification Number (NIP) 9691612376 (hereinafter referred to as the "Administrator").

User's Use of the Website and Personal Data Protection

The use of the T-overtone.art website is anonymous and does not require user registration or the provision of any data enabling the direct or indirect identification of the user in accordance with the provisions of the GDPR.

The Administrator only allows users to browse the content published on the website. The Administrator does not provide any functionality on the website that allows users to directly share personal data. However, users may provide their personal data by contacting the Administrator using the contact information provided on the website (email address, postal address, telephone) or by entering into a commercial relationship (contract).

The Website Administrator reserves the right to collect and process anonymous statistics regarding users to understand their preferences and evaluate compliance with the rules of using the website. The aforementioned data does not constitute personal data within the meaning of the GDPR and is not subject to the protection provided for therein.

## Cookies

The Website Administrator informs that "cookies" are stored on the user's end device when using the website. "Cookies" are short text information that includes computer data such as the website's name of origin, the duration of their storage on the user's end device, recorded parameters and statistics, and a unique number. "Cookies" are sent to the website server through the user's web browser installed on their end device.

Cookies are used on the website for the following purposes:

Ensuring the technical correctness and continuity of sessions between the website server and the user's end device.

Optimizing the user's use of the website's web pages and adapting their display on the user's end device.

Ensuring the security of website use.

Collecting statistics on website visits to support the improvement of their structure and content.

Displaying on the user's end device advertising content optimized to their preferences.

Two types of cookies are used on the website: "session cookies" and "persistent cookies." "Session cookies" are automatically deleted from the user's end device after they log out from the website, leave its web pages, or close the web browser. "Persistent cookies" are stored on the user's end device for the period specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the user. "Persistent cookies" are installed on the user's end device only with their consent.

The Administrator of the Website informs that:

Internet browsers accept by default the installation of "cookies" files on the User's final device. Each User of the Service may at any time make changes in the settings concerning "cookies" files in the Internet browser used by him in such a way that the browser automatically blocks the handling of "cookies" files, or informs the User about their each time they are placed on his final device. Detailed information about the possibility and ways of handling "cookies" files is available in the settings of the Internet browser used by the User of the Website.

Restricting the use of "cookies" by the User may adversely affect the correctness of display of information available on the Website.

Cookies" installed in the Service User's terminal equipment may be used by advertisers or business partners cooperating with the Service Administrator.

The content of "cookies" does not allow the Service Administrator to identify the identity of a User.

Only the Service Administrator has access to the "cookies" files processed by the Service server.

Changes to the Privacy Policy - In order to update the information contained in this Privacy Policy and its compliance with applicable laws, this Privacy Policy may be changed. If the content of the Privacy Policy is changed, the update date indicated at the end of its text will be changed. In order to inquire about how to protect personal data, the Administrator recommends that Users regularly read the provisions of the Privacy Policy.
